

Petrosea bersama Yayasan Bakti Barito Memperluas Implementasi Program *Green Guardians*

Jakarta, 17 September 2026 – Pada 15 September 2026, PT Petrosea Tbk (IDX:PTRO) meresmikan pelaksanaan program *Green Guardians* di wilayah Jakarta Barat melalui kolaborasi dengan Yayasan Bakti Barito, organisasi filantropi dari Barito Pacific Group, sebagai bagian dari upaya mendorong kepedulian terhadap lingkungan dan praktik keberlanjutan.

Program *Green Guardians* merupakan inisiatif pendidikan iklim dan pemberdayaan sekolah yang bertujuan meningkatkan pengetahuan serta kesadaran lingkungan melalui pengelolaan sampah, konservasi energi dan penerapan budaya berkelanjutan di lingkungan sekolah. Program ini diinisiasi oleh Yayasan Bakti Barito bersama sejumlah anak perusahaan Barito Pacific Group dan hingga saat ini telah menjangkau hampir 50.000 siswa di Kabupaten Garut, Provinsi Jawa Barat. Kolaborasi dengan Petrosea menandai perluasan pelaksanaan program *Green Guardians* ke wilayah Jakarta Barat.

“Petrosea berharap program ini dapat memperluas pengetahuan dan kepedulian terhadap lingkungan, sekaligus mendorong generasi muda menjadi penggerak aksi iklim. Sekolah menjadi ruang penting untuk menanamkan kepedulian lingkungan dan membentuk kebiasaan berkelanjutan sejak dini,” ujar Bitu Budiariani, Direktur Human Capital & General Services PT Petrosea Tbk.

“Sejalan dengan komitmen Petrosea terhadap pendidikan lingkungan, kami percaya bahwa pendekatan partisipatif dalam program *Green Guardians* dapat mendorong semakin banyak sekolah di Jakarta Barat untuk memenuhi indikator Adiwiyata dan meraih predikat Sekolah Adiwiyata,” ujar Dian A. Purbasari, Direktur Yayasan Bakti Barito.

Program *Green Guardians* akan diimplementasikan di 10 sekolah di Kecamatan Palmerah, Jakarta Barat dengan sasaran sekitar 2.000 siswa dan 150 guru serta tenaga pendidik. Dengan pendekatan pembelajaran partisipatif dan berbasis pengalaman, program ini mendampingi sekolah dalam memenuhi indikator Program Adiwiyata yang merupakan program pemerintah Indonesia untuk mendorong sekolah membangun budaya peduli dan berwawasan lingkungan. Acara peresmian turut dihadiri oleh jajaran Pemerintah Kota Jakarta Barat, termasuk Wali Kota Jakarta Barat, perwakilan Suku Dinas Lingkungan Hidup Jakarta Barat dan Suku Dinas Pendidikan Wilayah II Jakarta Barat. Kehadiran para pemangku kepentingan ini memperkuat sinergi dalam mendukung pendidikan lingkungan dan penerapan praktik berkelanjutan di sekolah.

“Bagi Petrosea, keberlanjutan tidak hanya diwujudkan melalui pengelolaan operasional yang bertanggung jawab, tetapi juga melalui investasi jangka panjang pada pendidikan dan peningkatan kesadaran generasi muda. Melalui kolaborasi ini, kami berharap dapat turut membangun fondasi perilaku berkelanjutan sejak dini serta menciptakan dampak positif yang terus berkembang di lingkungan sekolah dan masyarakat,” ujar Meinar Kusumastuti, Direktur Legal & Communications PT Petrosea Tbk.

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Petrosea and Yayasan Bakti Barito Expand the Implementation of the Green Guardians Program

Jakarta, 17 September 2026 – On 15 September 2026, PT Petrosea Tbk (IDX:PTRO) officially launched the Green Guardians program in West Jakarta in collaboration with Yayasan Bakti Barito, the philanthropic organization of Barito Pacific Group, as part of its efforts to promote environmental awareness and sustainable practices.

The Green Guardians program is a climate education and school empowerment initiative designed to enhance environmental knowledge and awareness through waste management, energy conservation and the adoption of sustainable practices in schools. This program was initiated by Yayasan Bakti Barito together with several subsidiaries of Barito Pacific Group and has reached nearly 50,000 students in Garut Regency, West Java Province. The collaboration with Petrosea marks the expansion of the Green Guardians program into West Jakarta.

“Petrosea hopes this program will broaden environmental knowledge and awareness while encouraging the younger generation to become drivers of climate action. Schools play an important role in fostering environmental awareness and building sustainable habits from an early age,” said Bitu Budiariani, Human Capital & General Services Director of PT Petrosea Tbk.

“In line with Petrosea’s commitment to environmental education, we believe that the participatory approach of the Green Guardians program can encourage more schools in West Jakarta to meet the Adiwiyata criteria and achieve Adiwiyata School status,” said Dian A. Purbasari, Director of Yayasan Bakti Barito.

The Green Guardians program will be implemented in 10 schools in Palmerah District, West Jakarta, targeting approximately 2,000 students and 150 teachers and education personnel. Through a participatory and experiential learning approach, the program will support schools in meeting the indicators of the Adiwiyata Program, an Indonesian government initiative that encourages schools to foster an environmentally conscious and sustainable culture. The launch event was attended by officials from the West Jakarta City Government, including the Mayor of West Jakarta, representatives of the West Jakarta Environmental Agency and the West Jakarta Region II Education Agency. The presence of these stakeholders reinforces collaboration in advancing environmental education and sustainable practices in schools.

“For Petrosea, sustainability is not only reflected in responsible operations, but also in long-term investment in education and raising environmental awareness among the younger generation. Through this collaboration, we hope to help lay the foundation for sustainable behaviors from an early age and create a positive impact that continues to grow within schools and the broader community,” said Meinar Kusumastuti, Legal & Communications Director of PT Petrosea Tbk.
